



RE: E-Verify Compliance

N.C. Legislation (S.L. 2013-418 HB318) has a significant impact on purchasing law because it imposes E-Verify requirements on most public contracts. The Bill requires local governments to verify that all contractors and their subcontractors comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes. This statute requires Employers to verify work authorization of employees through E-Verify. The City of Marion will no longer be able to enter into contracts for services, construction or installation with companies that do not have a current E-Verify Affidavit on file with our local government.

AFFIDAVIT of COMPLIANCE

With N.C. E-Verify Statutes

Employer understands that "E-Verify" is the federal E-Verify program operated by the United States Department of Homeland Security and other federal agencies, or any successor or equivalent program used to verify the work authorization of newly hired employees pursuant to federal law in accordance with NCGS §64-25(5).
3. Select one of the following statements:

_____ Employer employs 25 or more employees in the State of North Carolina, and is in compliance with the provisions of NCGS §64-26(a). Employer has verified the work authorization of its employees through E-Verify and shall retain the records of verification for a period of at least one year.

_____ Employer employs fewer than 25 Employees, and is therefore not subject to the provisions of NCGS §64-26(a).

4. All subcontractors engaged by or to be engaged by Employer have or will have likewise complied with the provisions of NCGS §64-26(a).
5. Employer shall keep the City of Marion, informed of any changes in its status pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes.
